Workers are denied the right to representation, a fair process and equal treatment. For many Ceres workers it is hard to see how Ceres are 'empowering communities' as they claim.^[3]

Ceres workers want the company to comply with the standards they claim as part of their certification. They also deserve job security and a liveable wage.
